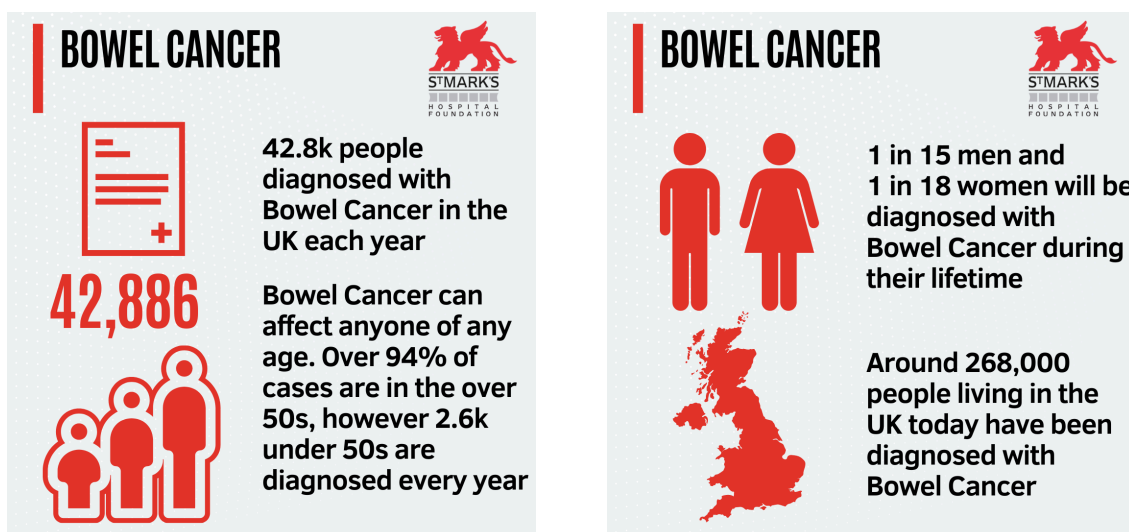




April is Bowel Cancer Awareness Month
