Advancing bowel cancer screening in the NHS




The DISCARD study – a collaboration between St Mark's Hospital and NHS England's Optical Diagnosis Implementation Team – has led to a national change in how small polyps are assessed during colonoscopy.

Using an optical diagnosis approach with a "resect and discard" strategy, clinicians can now safely remove tiny polyps without needing lab-based histopathology. This method is more efficient, environmentally friendly, cost-effective, and maintains high standards of patient care.

Led by Dr Ahmir Ahmad and Professor Brian Saunders from St Mark's, this approach is now being adopted across the NHS Bowel Cancer Screening Programme.

A major step forward for patients, the NHS, and sustainable healthcare.
